How to play Raindrop Rhythms:

This is a simple transition activity for MoonBeam 1 and SunBeam 2 students. Perfect for using after you introduce Ta dot Ti and the single Ti. (In Sunbeam 2 use this game to pre-teach H-6)

To play, students simply match each raindrop to the cloud collecting the number of beats.

Cards Included:

1) Rhythm Raindrops (MB1/SB2)

These cards feature a variety of beats perfect for review with your level 2s & 3s and when you teach ta dot ti to your MoonBeam 1s.
