## How to play The Farmer:

Assemble the game pieces and hand out a gameboard, cards, player and dice to each player. As players roll they move the number of beats of whatever they roll (eg half note dot moves 3). When they land on the different color dots they have to do a different number of cards to pass the dot. (Yellow = 1, Green = 2, Red = 3). Once they have answered the required number of cards they roll again and move along the path until they reach the end or the teacher calls last roll.

## Cards Included:

### 1) Review topics for G (SS2/SB1)

These cards feature a variety of topics  
Choose the Time signature  
Clap the rhythm  
Name the note (treble and bass G only)  
Staccato/legato touch  
pickup beat  
dynamics (cres, forte)  
patterns (Jump up high, jump down low)  
Repeat signs

If there is an included topic that you have not covered in class, simply remove the cards from the deck before handing it out.
