Whole Step/ Half Step Race MB2/SB3/MB3

How to play Whole Step/Half Step Race:

Two players face off against each other. Each put their player pawn at the start of the keyboard. Taking turns, have students pick one card at a time. If they pick up a half step, move one half step on the keyboard. For a card with a whole step, students get to move 2 half steps.

Game is won by the first student to reach the end of the keyboard

Cards Included: 1) Whole Step/Half Step (SB3/MB2/MB3)

These cards feature half steps and whole steps in a variety of ways. On the keyboard, on the staff & some cards with the words written down. There are some "lose a turn" cards, these are needed to space children out across the board, so resist the urge to remove them.
