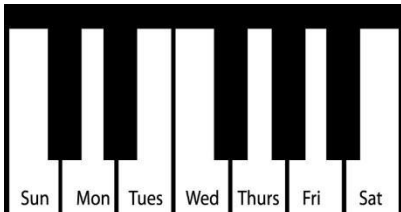

If your child forgets to play the B flat they will hear a sound that “doesn’t fit”. This is their ear providing a self-correcting mechanism.

Aurally, the student knows what a major key should sound like. Key signatures provide the visual clue.

Your teacher will work to help students become aware of key signatures before they begin to play. This process takes time and repetition.
