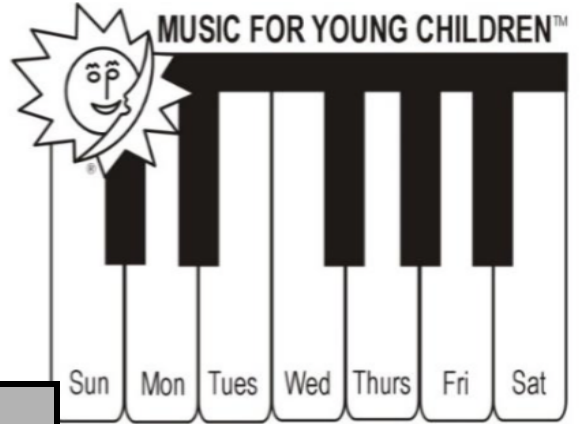











Level: Sunshine 1
