<b>P26 Angelfish</b> Work on page 2 Add pedal							
<b>Composing:</b> Work on your song. Does it have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Left hand (single note is best, think about the chord then choose a note from there)</li> <li>○ Phrases (or staccato)</li> <li>○ Dynamics</li> <li>○ Tempo</li> </ul>							
<b>Bright Ideas P. 22</b> (Use flashcards to help), <b>Pg 70</b> (For keys, look at first notes, last notes, and check for accidentals) <b>Pg 84</b> (Each line draw clef and a double bar line at end) <b>123</b> (Use circle of fifths. Bottom note: what is in its major scale? If top note is not in that scale, it is minor. If it is a 1, 4, 5 or 8 interval it is PERFECT, not maj/min) Bonus: <b>79</b>							
<b>Vocabulary (sticker/place to stick it): Tempo Primo, Slur, Marcato, leggiero</b>
