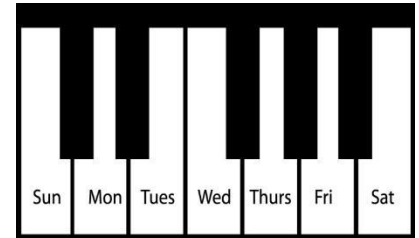




Tin sheet at home:
