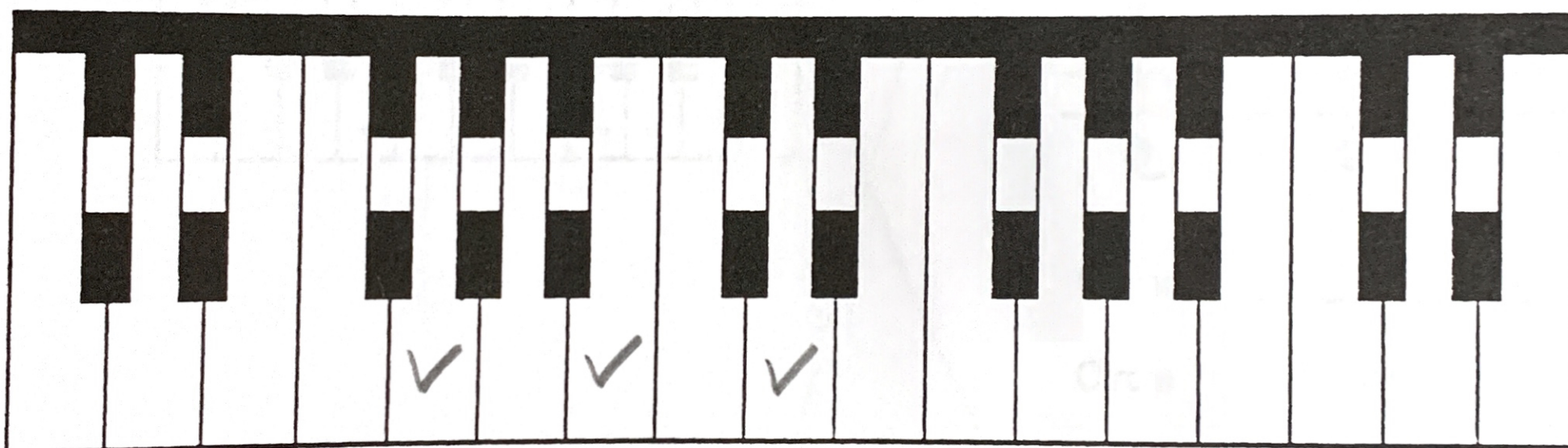
Primary Chords

Primary chords are built on the first, fourth, and fifth notes of a scale. That is why they are called I, IV, V.

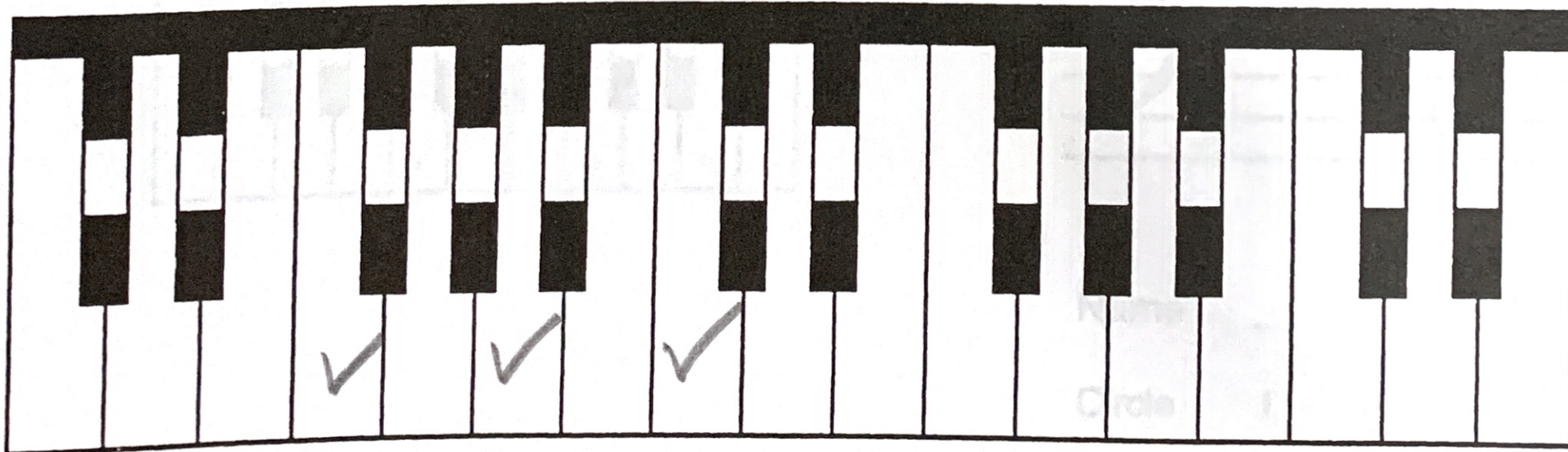
In the key of C major, very important chords are built on C, F and G.
