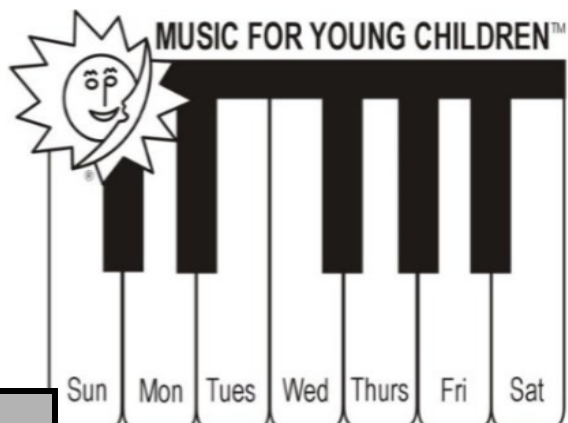

Singing 	I AM A STAR -Play for someone at Thanksgiving and have them sign your book. Solfege: Sing patterns with hand signs SSS= standing still (d d d) SPU: stepping up (d r m) SPD = Stepping down (m r d) SPU&D=Stepping up and down (dmrd)
